After the Covid recession in 2020, Delaware jobs have been growing at a rapid rate. As recently as January 2023, there were 18,100 more jobs, not seasonally adjusted, than the prior year. But throughout 2023 and into 2024 Delaware job growth has been slowing down to what might be considered a more normal rate of job growth during an economic expansion with 5,000 more jobs in March 2024 than the prior year. By industry, Transportation, Warehousing, & Utilities and Professional, Scientific, & Technical Services have been large contributors to the deceleration in over-the-year job growth.

Delaware Labor Force Trends

Delaware's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in March 2024 was 3.9%, down from 4.0% in February 2024. There were 20,000 unemployed Delawareans in March 2024 compared to 19,500 in March 2023. The US unemployment rate was 3.8% in March 2024, down from 3.9% in February 2024. In March 2023, the US unemployment rate was 3.5%, while Delaware rate was 3.9%.

In March 2024, seasonally adjusted nonfarm employment was 488,500, up from 487,900 in February 2024. Since March 2023, Delaware's total nonfarm jobs have increased by a net gain of 5,000, a rise of 1.0%. Nationally, jobs during that period increased by 1.9%.


